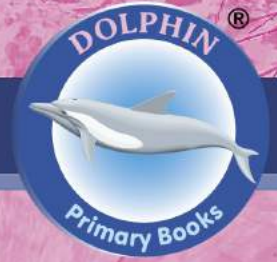

When shall I learn my ABC?



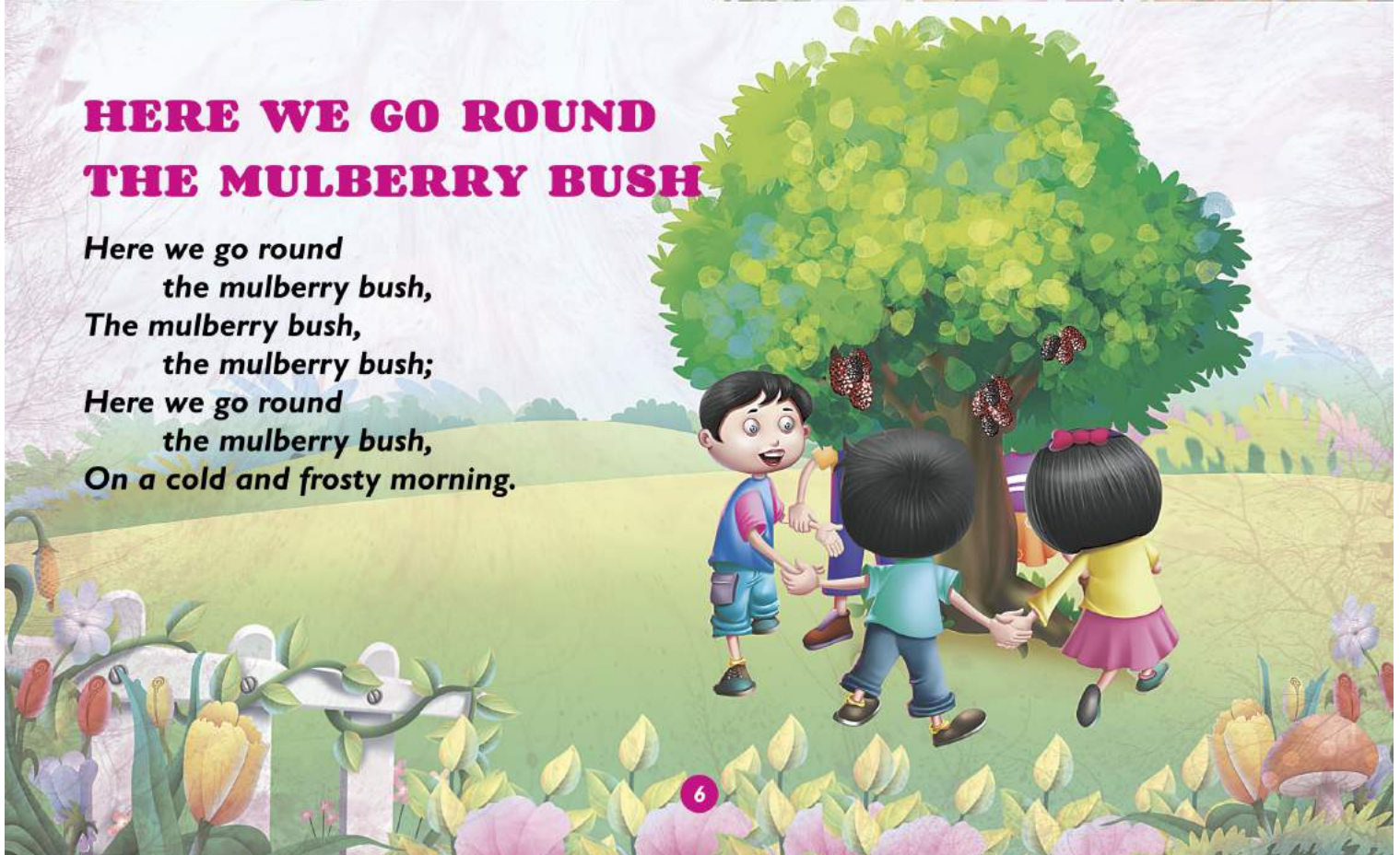


OUT IN THE GARDEN

6. THE CLEVER MONKEY AND THE FOOLISH CATS

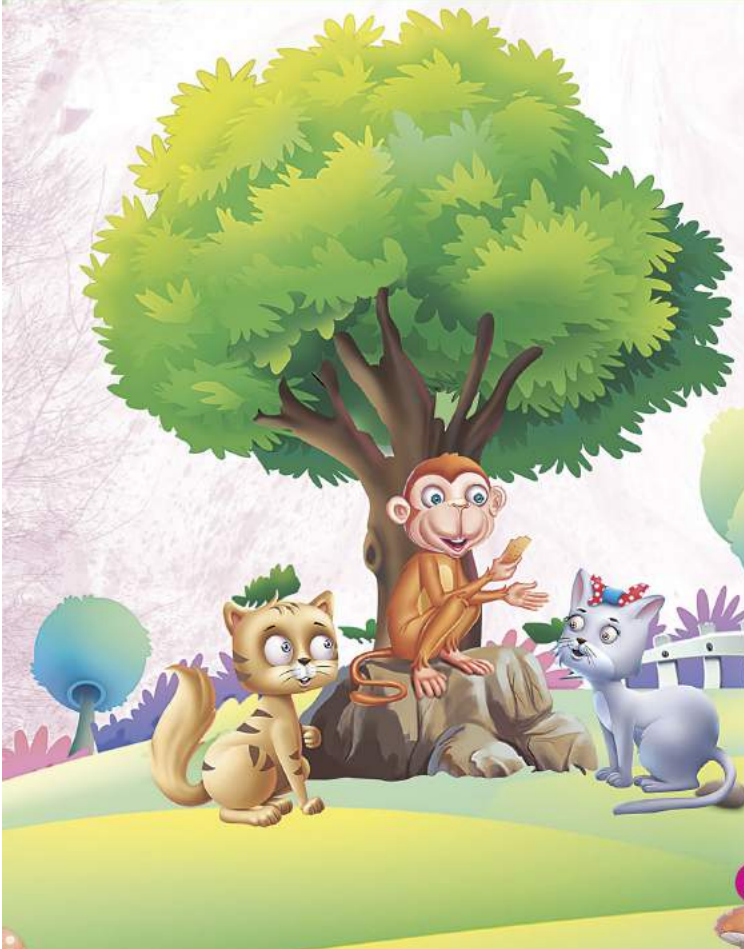
Once, two cats were quarrelling over a big biscuit they found in the street. At that time there came a monkey on the way.

To make it equal in size he continued to bite both the pieces. They became very small and unequal in size.

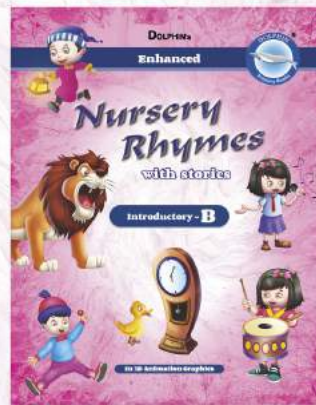
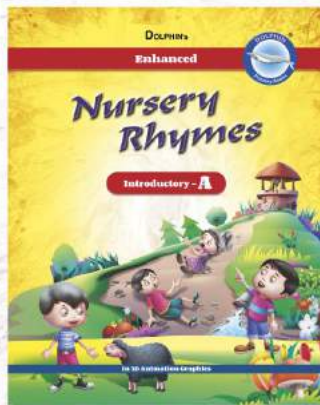
"Let me have these two small pieces for myself. I have spent a lot of time to solve your problem", said the monkey and left the scene. The foolish cats got disappointed.
