Writing in cursive style makes our presentation more attractive and artistic. The stroke pattern recommended here, improves our writing speed appreciable when we join letters together. To learn this writing pattern, these ideas can help you more.

- * It's a step by step process, where children need to focus the systematic process and sequencing implemented in this series. The page numbers are fixes calculative in each series to maintain patience and gain legibility.
- * Beginners may find practising the Cursive Capital letters more complicated. If so, kindly skip the content for the time being and proceed with small letters. The same can be combined on a latter stage when he or she gains confidence.
- * Simple English vocabulary practices and grammar exercises are combined as copy writing activities to revise and practice more and more.
- * Children love to read content from their own handwriting. Insist, encourage and applaud the child to read the page traced and copied.
- * Hold your patience. Provide a quite, comfortable and rewarding atmosphere, as your child needs repeated practice to grab the style, understand the directions and gain the momentum.
- * Limit each session with one or two pages.

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
